fordholm road stage 3 works

we started working on the refurbishment of the existing 1940's residence in mid 2004. a few years later the stage 2 works, which involved utilising the existing roof space for an additional bedroom, and study with views over the city, were carried out.

the stage 3 works are now reaching completion and will be fully realised when the client's green thumb goes to work. a 1970's single storey addition has been replaced, creating a new kitchen, pantry, living area, laundry, and library. the old garage has a new lease of life as the pool house rumpus room, forming a sheltered courtyard in between the two new buildings.

fordholm road has been a significant project for us; our involvement in all aspects of the architectural and interior design, and the development of a close relationship, with both the client and builder (lyon constructions) over 7 years, has resulted in a satisfying project process and result for all concerned. although we are excited about its realisation we are also sad that this marks the close of this particular chapter of the fordholm road story.
